# Tutorial: Making a Zine from a Single Piece of Paper

#### **SUPPLIES:**

- 1. Scissors
- 2. A marker or pen
- 3. Paper (colored or blank)



#### STEP 1:

Hamburger fold your piece of paper by folding the left side to the right.



Hamburger fold your piece of paper again.


#### STEP 3:

Hamburger fold your piece of paper one last time.

#### **STEP 4:**

Unfold your piece of paper all the way back to the start.









#### **STEP 5:**

Hamburger fold your piece of paper by folding the left side to the right again.

#### STEP 6:


Draw a line on the middle fold, stopping in the middle as shown.


#### **STEP 7:**


Cut along the drawn line, making sure not to cut any further.


#### **STEP 8:**

Unfold your piece of paper all the way back to the start.









The hole should now be in the middle of your piece of paper.

#### STEP 9:

Fold the paper hotdog style so that the opening is now on the top of your folded paper.

#### **STEP 10:**

Pinch the two ends toward the center to form a "+" shape.

#### **STEP 11:**

Fold all the flaps toward one direction (left or right).
