Paper (Cut-Out) Diagram Solar System

SUPPLIES:

Scissors
A marker or pen
Paper (colored or blank)
Glue (or tape)



STEP 1:


Pick an empty page in your zine to make your diagram.

STEP 2:

Using colored pieces of paper, draw the shapes you would like to cut out.

Tip:

If you don't want the marker lines that you drew to show in your final diagram, you can glue down the side with markings, to create a "clean" shape.








If you do not have colored paper:

Using a marker or colored pencil, create a patch of color on a piece of paper.


Once you have your color patch, cut out whichever shape you would like to use in your diagram.

STEP 3:

Using liquid glue, a glue stick, or tape, begin attaching your diagram shapes.







STEP 4:

Once you have all your cut-outs glued down, add in the key elements of a diagram: the title and labels.
