Making a Pop-Up

SUPPLIES:

1. *Scissors*
2. *Paper (colored or blank)*
3. *Glue (or tape)*



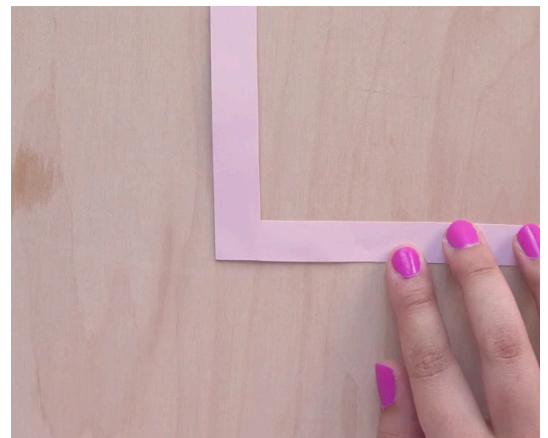
STEP 1:

Cut two thin strips of paper about the width of your finger.



STEP 2:

Lay out the strips in an "L" shape so they are perpendicular to one another.



*Tip:
This next part is a little tricky, so following along with the video tutorial is highly recommended.*

STEP 3:

Glue the paper strips together.

STEP 4:

Alternating between the two paper strips, fold the bottom strip so that it is on top. Then, repeat with the other paper strip.

Tip:

One paper strip will always be folded up and down, and the other will always be folded left and right.

STEP 5:

After folding, glue the ends of your strips to secure your spring. Follow the video for next steps.
